

CIVIC AWARDS CRITERIA

Once a year Ferryhill Town Council requests residents and voluntary organisations to nominate those unsung heroes who do so much to improve the quality of life in Ferryhill.

If you know a resident or young person of Ferryhill who has performed some act or helped in some way to benefit others living in the town or any other action, which has achieved success in any field, then why not nominate them for a Civic Award.

Please consider the following criteria before submitting your nomination.

- a. A maximum of three awards be given in any one year.
- b. Nominees must reside within the Ferryhill Town Council boundary or have provided a community service within that area.
- c. Nominations must have been proposed by residents living within the Ferryhill Town Council boundary.
- d. Nominees should not be paid for the activities for which they are nominated
- e. Nominees should not have received a Civic Award previously
- f. Nominations will not be considered in respect of any serving Town Councillor or Town Council Officer, or within 2 years of their retirement.
- g. Nominations should not be initiated by serving Town Councillors or Officers of the Town Council, or within 2 years of their retirement.
- h. Nominations will be considered on their own merits by the Events Management & Community Engagement Sub-Committee. Their decision will be final.
