4. EXCLUSION OF PRESS AND PUBLIC

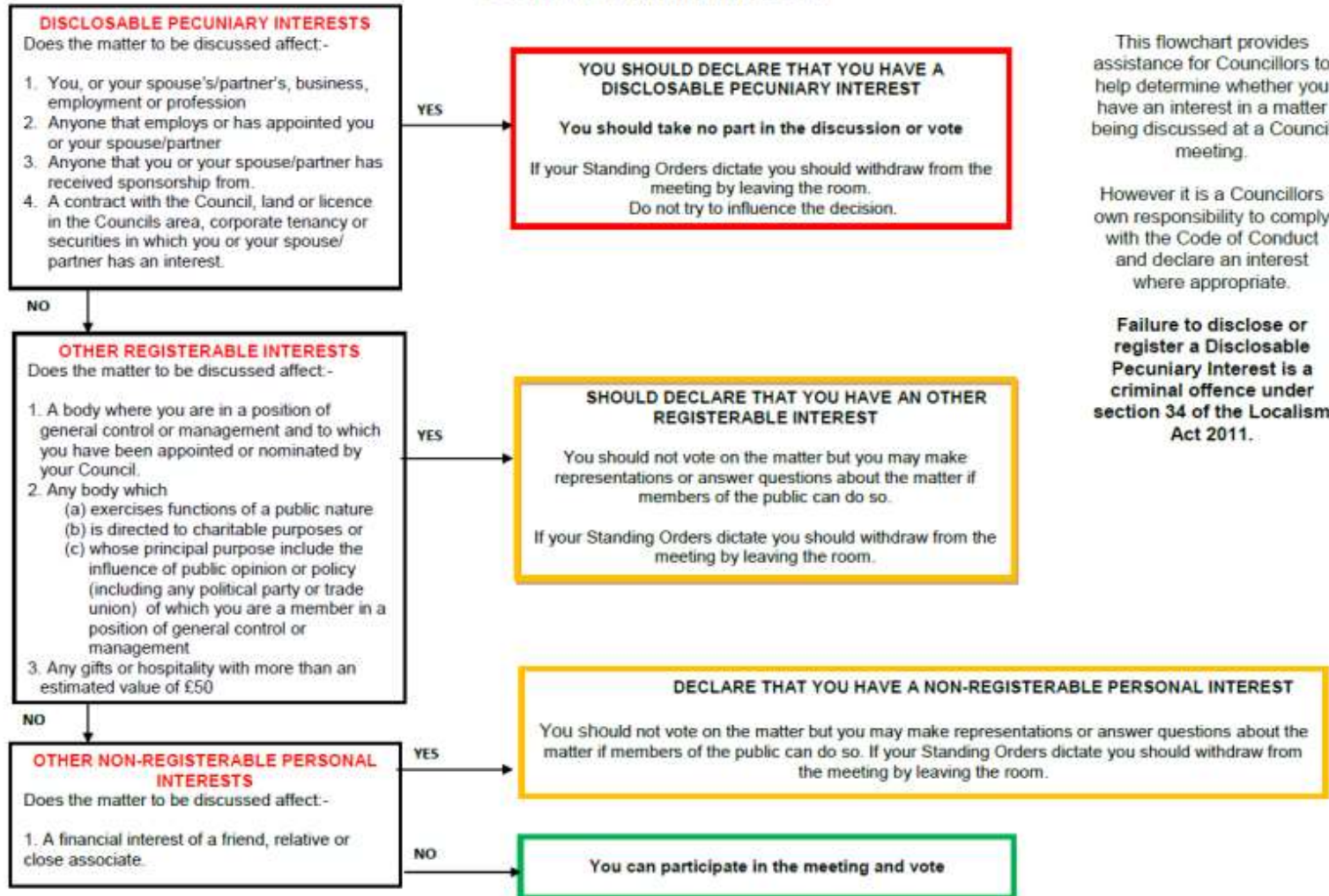
Members are requested to move the following motion:
