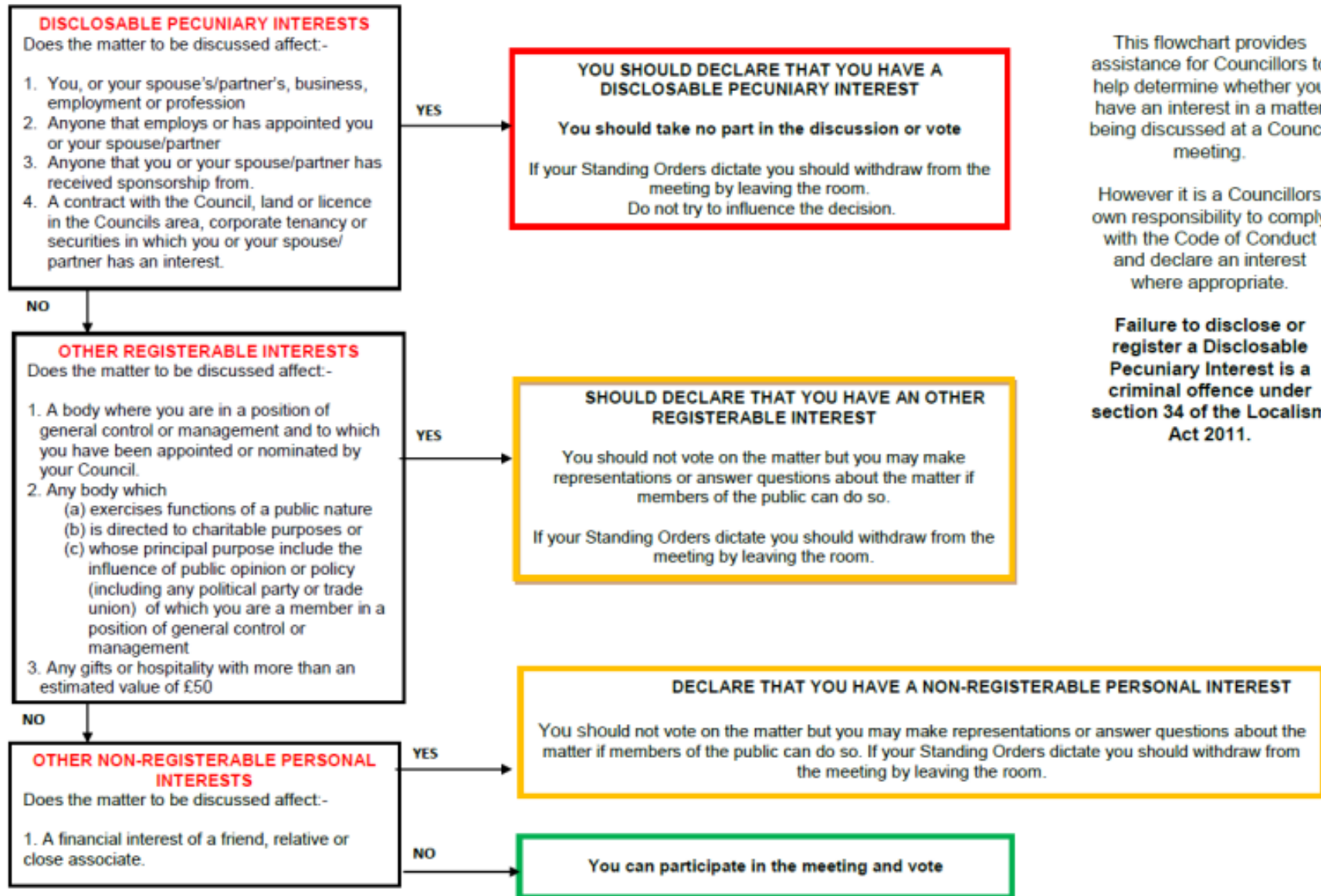
**15. Exclusion of Press and Public**
